

# Vaccinations

## Indiana will begin administering vaccine by age

- Hoosiers age 80 and older can begin making appointments on Friday to receive vaccine

Then, as more vaccine is available, the next eligible groups will be:

- 70 and older age group
- 60 and older age group

We will notify you as vaccine is available for these next age groups



# Vaccinations by age group

The goal is to save the most lives and have the greatest impact on reducing hospitalizations

Hoosiers 80 and older account for **3.8%** of the state population but more than **19%** of the hospitalizations and **52%** of COVID-19 deaths in the state



# Vaccinations by age group

Impact of immunizing Hoosiers 60 and older:

**22.5%** of all **Hoosiers**

**64.1%** of all COVID-19 **hospitalizations**

**93.3%** of all COVID-19 **deaths**

**Goal:** Save the most lives while reducing hospitalizations



# Vaccinations to-date

Total first-dose vaccinations given as of Jan. 6:  
**128,026**

Total second-dose vaccinations given as of Jan. 6:  
**585**

Number of Hoosiers scheduled to be vaccinated by end of month:  
**300,000**

**Appointments for these populations continue**



# Vaccinations to-date

**Dec. 16:** Started vaccinating healthcare workforce

**Dec. 28:** CVS and Walgreens began vaccinating residents and staff in long-term care facilities, skilled nursing and assisted living

Have also opened vaccinations up to firefighters, EMS, law enforcement, and Department of Correction officers



# Vaccinations: Next Populations

**Age group:** 80 and older

**When:** Appointments can be made starting Friday

This age group represents:

257,324, or **3.8%** of Hoosiers

**19.6%** of COVID-19 hospitalizations

**52.3%** of COVID-19 deaths



# Vaccination clinic sites

At least 1 vaccination clinic will be available in every county

148 clinics statewide

- **55 hospital locations**
- **91 local health departments**
- **2 pharmacy locations in Newton and Posey counties**



# Vaccinations: Next Populations

**Age group:** 70 and older

**When:** As doses are available

This age group represents:

470,009, or **7%** of Hoosiers

**23%** of COVID-19 hospitalizations

**26%** of COVID-19 deaths





# Vaccinations: Next Populations

**Age group:** 60 and older

**When:** As doses are available

This age group represents:

784,826, or **11.7%** of Hoosiers

**21.5%** of COVID-19 hospitalizations

**26%** of COVID-19 deaths



# Vaccinations: What you need to know

## Go to [ourshot.in.gov](https://ourshot.in.gov) starting 9 a.m. Friday

- Click the link to go to the registration site
- Enter your zip code to see a map of vaccination clinics
- Register yourself or an eligible person using their name and age
- Person receiving vaccination must bring photo identification to appointment
- Family member may make appointments for a senior
- Vaccinations are free



# Vaccinations: What you need to know

## Call 2-1-1 beginning 9 a.m. Friday

- Call center representative will make appointment for a senior, or you may call on a senior's behalf, if you do not have access to the internet
- Call center hours: **8 a.m. to 8 p.m.** daily, including weekends

Appointment to receive second dose will be made at the clinic when first dose is administered. Reminder messages will be sent.
